First Sunday of Advent

See, the days are coming - it is the Lord who speaks - when I am going to fulfil the promise I made to the House of Israel and the House of Judah: 'In those days and at that time, I will make a virtuous Branch grow for David, who shall practise honesty and integrity in the land. Jer 33:14-16

We live in times when honesty and integrity is much needed to bring peace to our community and to our world. How will we prepare for Christmas?



There has been much in the media about education, including the need for students in primary school, to learn coding, as an introduction to computer science. Our Year 5, iLearn grade, are engaging in coding tutorials and will be participating in Hour of Code, promoted by the Board of Studies, Teaching and Educational Standards, NSW. Hour of Code is available to all students from home and school from Monday 7 to Sunday 13 December at https://hourofcode.com/au Parents are

encouraged to support their child's participation in this learning opportunity.

To enable greater student engagement with learning technology in 2016, Mrs McGannon has been appointed as Lead Teacher, eLearning. She will be working with teachers and students, especially in Years 4-6. Participation in the BYOD program will enable students to access tutorials and continue their learning projects at home. We have purchased a further bank of iPads for use at school. Our technical support and teacher learning supports Apple iPads so they are the preferred device for students to use at St Joseph's Primary School.



Apple offers special iPad and Mac pricing for students attending Catholic Education Office, Diocese of Parramatta (CEDP) schools. Families can visit their local Penrith Apple Store and let them know that they are from a Parramatta Catholic School or go online http://byod.parra.catholic.edu.au to get special pricing, advice or to discuss the products that they might be considering. Our Year 5 iLearn group use iPad Air devices. Students save work to google drive, so a large memory is not required for school. While only Years 4 & 5 will BYOD in 2016, parents may wish to purchase a

device for younger students to develop their technology skills at home. We will advise all parents in 2016 how to access the apps used at school for learning.

Sunday the 29th of November is the first day of the Church's new liturgical year. This Sunday is the first Sunday in the season of Advent; a time to prepare for the coming of the Lord, Jesus Christ.

You might like to have an Advent Wreath as a focal point at home for the next three Sundays. You will need a circular green wreath, three purple candles and one pink candle (or four white candles). The circle of the wreath is a reminder that God's love is eternal. The candles are a sign of the, light of Christ. This week you can light one of the purple candles.



Advent means coming. This is the season that we wait for the coming of the Lord. And, as Jesus tells us today, not only do we sit and wait, but we get up and get ready. <u>Skoolbag App</u>

In 2016 we will distribute all school notes through Skoolbag. Our final two newsletters this year will be printed as usual as well as sent out through the Skoolbag app to allow parents to check that we have the correct contact details for them. There are 2 eforms already available on the Skoolbag app. You can now send an absent now through the Absentee Forms. You can also send your Change of Details through the app.

How To Install Skoolbag On Your Smartphone

For iPhone and iPad users:

- 1. Click the "App Store" icon on your Apple device.
- 2. Type your school name in the search, using suburb name will help.
- 3. You will see your school appear, click "Get" then "install".
- 4. The app is FREE to download.
- 5. When installed click "Open"
- 6. Select "OK" to receive push notifications, when asked.
- 7. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup".
- 8. Toggle on the Push Categories that are applicable for you by tapping the on/off switch.

For Android users:

You must first have signed up with a Google Account before installing the app.

- 1. Click the "Play Store" button on your Android Device
- Click the magnifying glass icon at the top and type in your school name, using suburb name will help.
- 3. Click the school name when it appears in the search.
- 4. Click the "Install" button.
- Click "Accept" for various permissions (please note, we do not modify any of your personal data on your device).
- 6. Click "Open" when installed.
- 7. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup".
- 8. Toggle on the Push Categories that are applicable for you by tapping the on/off switch.

Please Note: Some brands of Android phones need the setting in "Notification Manager" changed to "Allow" instead of "Notify" in order for the push notifications to work. The phone must also be running at least version 4 system software to run the app.

For Windows 81 Phone and Windows 81 or 10 device users:

- 1. Go to the Windows Store on your 81 Windows Phone or Windows 81/10 Device
- 2. Search for "Skoolbag" in the keyword app search
- 3. Install the Skoolbag app
- 4. Find your school either by using the keyword search or location service.
- 5. Click the "Pin" icon to pin the school tile to your Windows Phone home screen.
- 6. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup"
- 7. Toggle the Push Categories that are applicable to you by tapping the on/off switch.
