We had an amazing experience at our Possum Magic workshops! We dramatised parts of the story by going on a magical adventure with Grandma Poss and Hush.










We have been mathematicians doing HARD thinking and solving problems in Maths.

We also made a tree that shows how Learning Helps Us To Grow







team 4 Celebration of Learning
