Our Church has declared this to be an extraordinary year of mercy. Throughout the year the students will learn, reflect, pray and live Jesus' mercy as a way of becoming closer to God. We have a number of key events coming up in the next few weeks. The first of these is the ceremony of the Burning of Ashes, which will be on Shrove Tuesday - 9th February. The meaning of this ceremony will be fully explained to the students as part of their preparation for Lent.



Wednesday 10th February is Ash Wednesday. The students will be participating in a Liturgy of the Word at which they will receive the ashes on their foreheads Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent for Catholics. The ashes we receive on our forehead in the shape of a cross serve as an outward sign of our need for penance. The ashes also symbolize our human frailty.

The annual Mass for World Day of the Sick will be celebrated in the Diocese of Parramatta on 11 February 2016, the feast of Our Lady of Lourdes. The Mass will be an acknowledgment of carers and those for whom they care and will include the Sacramental Rite of Anointing of the Sick and Prayers for Healing. Year 6 will attend this celebration in our Church.



Our first, whole school, Mass for this year will be held on Monday 15th February at 9am. This will also be the commissioning Mass for our student leaders for 2016. Parents and guardians are invited to join us for this great occasion.

As you can see, the term is already quite full of activity.



Catholic Schools Week will commence with a community Mass on Sunday the 6th March, at 10am. School Tours will be available 11:30am – 1pm for families looking at enrolling their children in 2016/2017.

In this Year of Mercy we look to Jesus, our example, God our strength who loves us and forgives us with unbounded mercy and to the Spirit who inspires us to be like Christ in our dealings with each person we meet.

- 7. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup".
- 8. Toggle on the Push Categories that are applicable for you by tapping the on/off switch.

For Android users:

You must first have signed up with a Google Account before installing the app.

- 1. Click the "Play Store" button on your Android Device
- Click the magnifying glass icon at the top and type in your school name, using suburb name will help.
- 3. Click the school name when it appears in the search.
- 4. Click the "Instail" button.
- Click "Accept" for various permissions (please note, we do not modify any of your personal data on your device).
- 6. Click "Open" when installed.
- 7. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup".
- 8. Toggle on the Push Categories that are applicable for you by tapping the on/off switch.

Please Note: Some brands of Android phones need the setting in "Notification Manager" changed to "Allow" instead of "Notify" in order for the push notifications to work. The phone must also be running at least version 4 system software to run the app.

For Windows 81 Phone and Windows 81 or 10 device users:

- 1. Go to the Windows Store on your 81 Windows Phone or Windows 81/10 Device
- 2. Search for "Skoolbag" in the keyword app search
- 3. Install the Skoolbag app
- 4. Find your school either by using the keyword search or location service.
- 5. Click the "Pin" icon to pin the school tile to your Windows Phone home screen.
- 6. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup"
- 7. Toggle the Push Categories that are applicable to you by tapping the on/off switch.

Urgent information! Changed Procedure to Morning Drop Off Beginning: Monday 8th February 2016

We have been reviewing our Work Health and Safety Procedures and will be implementing changed procedures for morning student drop off as from next Monday 8th February 2016.

All school gates will be locked until 8.20am when playground supervision begins.

Parents dropping children at Joey's in the morning will follow their usual procedure using the intercom at the gate.

Once gates are unlocked at 8.20am, they will be 'manned' by a staff member.

Staff at the gates will receive children and direct them to their area. Parents will not be able to walk their child to the playground.

Parents attending the school assembly on Mondays or needing to enter the school grounds for any school meeting or event, must sign in at the front office and wear a visitor's badge and follow staff instructions re time of entry.

These changes to procedure are to create a safe environment for all our students and in response to diverse situations and events.
