All the staff have been very busy working on school reports, Year 6 farewell, Kindergarten 2017 orientation, as well as all their normal 'teacher duties'.

I would like to share some of my reflections of St Joseph's Primary School

'Over the past 4 weeks I have grown to admire and appreciate the strength and dedication within our school community. Given the great changes that have taken place, there continues to beat a professional, spiritual and communal heart, a beat that is 'strong and constant.'

Each Monday our teachers in association with Fr.Andrew facilitate an assembly that celebrates student success and growth. At these assemblies Fr.Andrew shares the Gospel and supports student understanding in reflecting on 'What Jesus is telling us' and What Jesus is asking us to do.' Each and every Monday we reinforce positive behaviour, acceptance and tolerance of difference. At these assemblies I have been taken by the student's collective engagement and sincere appreciation of the successes of their peers.

When I review the work of our school team, my appraisal suggests a high level of 'Unity of Purpose.' Each day we begin with Case Management meetings. These meetings allow for class teachers to bring forward students who are requiring a higher level of support in ensuring successful outcomes in learning. At these meetings school leadership, Leading educators and Teaching Educators review all data and collaboratively plan next steps in a student's Personal plan.

You may remember in my earlier newsletters I spoke of our term 4 Goal in creating our 2017 Action Plan. This goal included the building and empowering of 'Action Teams.' Over the past two weeks our teaching teams have spent time reviewing 2016 plans, all small and big data and planning next steps in supporting professional learning and student growth. In 2017 we will continue our work in, Writing, Number and Knowledge of our Church through Scripture and Prayer

While Goals and strategies are vital to our success, the 'High Yield' is seeing a teaching team that is 'Leading the Learning.' In 2017 our teachers will continue to grow a consistent pedagogy that draws from contemporary practice. As I worked through a variety of team strategies I was struck by the high levels of passion and trust shown by my colleagues in challenging ideas and bringing forward professional needs. Above all our teachers all have one thing in common and that is a Belief that, "all children can will succeed and grow."

Over these few weeks I have been struck by a 'Parent Community' that holds great belief and hope for our work and for our future. I have enjoyed working with parents at assemblies, Disco Nights, Parents and Friends and the Year 6 Graduation. All of these parents have shown a willingness to work in cooperation in ensuring the continued growth of our school.

Finally these few weeks have allowed for the securing of our 2017 Leadership and Staffing positions. Mrs Patricia Reilly, (Principal), Ms Lisa Howell Assistant Principal) and Mr Phillip Magerison (Religious Education Coordinator) bring rich and varied experiences in education and leadership. Over these past weeks these leaders have been working closely with our teaching team in review and planning for 2017.

As you can see our future is not only planned it is assured.'



2017 Parramatta Diocesan Team Sport Trials

Any Primary students enrolled in Parramatta Diocesan Schools in Year 5 and 6 in 2017 are invited to participate in the Parramatta Diocesan Team Sport Trials during Term One/Two in 2017 (Winter Sports - AFL, Football, Hockey, Netball, Rugby League League, Rugby Union & Touch).

It is important to note that these trials are generally for those children who display an above average ability and/or have representative experience in their chosen sport. While teams are open in age it is strongly recommended that only children of a representative standard in Years 5 & 6 in 2017 be invited to attend.

Parramatta Diocesan trials in 2017 will be held in the following sports:

*AFL (boys), Diving (B&G), Hockey (B&G), Football (B&G), Golf (B&G), Hockey (B&G), Netball (girls), Rugby League (11yrs & Opens), Rugby Union (boys), & Touch(B&G).

To be eligible for selection for these trials an Online Team Registration Form must be completed that can be accessed via the website

www.primarysportparra.catholic.edu.au. This online form is an EXPRESSION OF INTEREST for the 2017 Parramatta Diocesan Primary Sport Team trials. You may complete this form to attend a selection trial or if you have been selected in a representative squad or team. One form is to be completed per child, per individual sport. Each sport has its own criteria therefore, it is imperative that the correct form is completed.

Please note that your online registration is an **EXPRESSION OF INTEREST ONLY** and **MUST** be approved by your child's school. In order for your child to attend the nominated trial or event this may come down to the discretion of your school as to who is selected to attend the trial. In some sports only 2 students per school can be nominated. **Please complete all fields and especially "Representative Experience".**

Please ensure that the SUBMIT button has been pressed upon completing the form and notification email will be sent to the parent/guardian listed on the form confirming this expression of interest has been received.

Your child's school will notify you one week prior to the trial date if your child is to attend to the Parramatta Diocesan trial for their selected sport by providing a trial information sheet.

Under no circumstances will a child be eligible to trial if the Online Registration Form has not been completed and approved by the school by the closing date.

Winter Sports Registrations close Friday 3rd February 5pm.
