




#### Year 2 Celebration of Learning - Writing

This week we were lucky enough to be visited by two Penrith Panthers Players.






They came and assisted us with our Science PBL and answered a few of our students keen questions!

We would like to thank them for coming and sharing some of their advice on teamwork and collaboration!




